Terms, Conditions & Notes

Delivery & Pick-Up

<u>In person</u>: By federal law, whoever drops the firearm off, must also be the person who picks it up. Since we will be keeping your firearm more than 24 hours, we must log your firearm into our records log, along with your driver's license information. If someone other than the person who dropped off the gun will be picking it up, then they must complete the standard federal and state transfer forms, and undergo a background check.

<u>Shipping via UPS/FedEx</u>: If you are shipping your firearm to us, contact us for instructions. You will be charged a shipping and handling fee for the return of your firearm.

Condition of Your Firearm

DuraCoat finishes require the application surface to be absolutely free of all dirt, residue, grime, lubricants, etc. As part of the process, we thoroughly clean and degrease the components to be coated. Please deliver your firearm components to us as clean as humanly possible. If the parts require more than a cursory cleaning, you will be charged an additional cleaning fee.

Bright, Light & Metallic Colors

Some colors may require an additional priming undercoat. Some, but not all, of the colors requiring and additional undercoat include: pink, yellow, lime green, lavender, red and orange.

Deposit & Pricing

A 50% deposit of the pre-quoted price is due prior to any work. Balance is due when the item is picked up or prior to shpping.

All prices above reflect a 4% discount for cash/check purchases. For Visa/MC/Discover purchases, add 4%. Prices and availability are subject to change without notice. *CGI Guns & Training / Catoctin Group Inc* is not responsible for typographical errors.

You will be notified if any additional fees are to be incurred, and will have the option to decline and cancel your work order.

Sights

If we have to remove and re-install your sights, then *CGI Guns & Training / Catoctin Group Inc* assumes no responsibility whatsoever for any damage to your sights. If removal and re-installation of the sights will be required, then it is highly recommended that you remove them prior to delivering your firearm.

Curing Time & Permanence

Initial setting and curing takes only 24-48 hours. Assembly and the use of lubricants can occur after initial setting. It is recommended that you only subject your DuraCoated firearm to light use until full curing. Full curing takes 4-6 weeks, depending on temperature and humidity.

Once fully cured, DuraCoat is virtually impervious to corrosion and scratching. Although it is an incredibly strong coating, Duracoat "flexes" to an extent. This is what makes it less prone to chipping or cracking under extreme use. Once fully cured, DuraCoat is a permanent finish not easily removed.

NOTES

1) Stripped – the removal of <u>all</u> components that will not be DuraCoated. For example, a stripped slide will be the bare metal slide, with all firing pin components, extractor components, safety components, sights, etc., removed. (See comment regarding sights above.) A stripped frame is the bare frame with no internal components.

2) Dis-assembly/Assembly – we will take all due reasonable and diligent care in handling your firearm. However, since the condition and quality of the internal components of a firearm can vary drastically, *CGI Guns & Training / Catoctin Group Inc* assumes no responsibility whatsoever for the internal components of your firearm. It is highly recommended and preferred that you deliver only the stripped components you wish to have DuraCoated.

3) Rifles/Shotguns – This note pertains primarily to AR/AK type firearms, but is applicable to any barrel that receives DuraCoating. If you fire your rifle at a sustained near-full-auto rate of fire, the barrel may exceed the 550°F temperature tolerance of DuraCoat. While not all probable, it is theoretically possible.

4) Revolvers – There are many options for revolvers: frame only; cylinder only; frame & cylinder (but not the hammer, trigger and cylinder latch), two-tone, etc. Also, due to the intricate internal mechanisms of some revolvers, it may be preferable to remove only the cylinder mechanism and mask the sights, trigger hammer, and internals, rather than totally disassembling the revolver. 5) NAA Mini-Revolvers – Mini-Revolvers do not require dis-assembly of the frame. Price also includes extra cylinder in the case of .22LR/.22WMR Mini-Revolvers with interchangeable cylinders.

6) Two-Tone – There are numerous ways to do a two tone on a revolver. Contact us to discuss your options.
